Privacy Policy:

- 1. You will need to add a privacy policy if you don't already have one.
- 2. A company's privacy policy should clearly state how customer information is collected, used, and shared. The policy should be easy to find and linked on all pages (footer or header).
- 3. The privacy policy should be on a single page. The sharing section must explicitly state: "Mobile authorization, SMS consent, and phone numbers collected for SMS communication purposes will not be shared with any third parties or affiliates for marketing purposes."
- 4. Here's the following template:

PRIVACY POLICY

Introduction: Give an overview of your company and the purpose of the privacy policy.

Types of Information Collected: Specify the types of personal information collected from customers (e.g. name, email address).

Method of Information Collection: Describe how customer data is collected.

Purpose of Data Collection: Explain why customer information is collected and how it will be utilized.

Data Security Measures: Detail the security measures implemented to safeguard customer data from unauthorized access or misuse.

Data Sharing: Disclose whether customer data will be shared with third parties and under what circumstances. Include the following disclaimer in this section: Mobile Opt in, SMS Consent, and phone numbers collected for SMS communication purposes will not be shared with any third party or affiliates for marketing purposes.

User Rights: Inform customers of their rights regarding their personal information, such as accessing, updating, or deleting their data.
